**ORDER AUTHORIZING LOSS MITIGATION PROGRAM PROCEDURES  
FOR CHAPTER 13 CASES ASSIGNED TO JUDGE GRANT**

At Fort Wayne, Indiana, on August 12, 2011.

WHEREAS, a court supervised loss mitigation program may facilitate consensual resolutions for individual debtors whose residential real property is at risk of loss to foreclosure; and

WHEREAS, a loss mitigation program may avoid the need for litigation, reduce costs to debtors and secured creditors, and enable debtors to reorganize or otherwise address their most significant debts and assets under the United States Bankruptcy Code; and

WHEREAS, the “Loss Mitigation Program Procedures” annexed to this Order and the “Loss Mitigation Program” described therein have been developed in conjunction with the bar and with the active participation of representatives of both debtors and creditors; it is hereby

ORDERED that, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105(a), effective September 1, 2011, the Loss Mitigation Program Procedures attached hereto are adopted and shall apply in all chapter 13 cases assigned to Chief Judge Robert E. Grant; and it is further

ORDERED that the Loss Mitigation Program Procedures shall be available in the Clerk’s Office and on the Court’s website. The Court may modify the Loss Mitigation Program Procedures from time to time by Order, and in that event, shall make the revised Loss Mitigation Program Procedures available in the Clerk’s Office and on the Court’s website immediately.
